- Book your appointments with your child's main class teacher using Insight, our online booking system.
- Insight will be open for appointment bookings from 12 noon on Monday 12 November and will close at 12 noon on Thursday 15 November 2018.
- For any careers, Sixth Form, college or apprenticeship advice, please book an appointment with Mrs McKay, Careers Officer.
- Appointments slots are between 4.30pm and 7.00pm.
- Due to the limited number of slots available you will only be able to book one 5 minute appointment with each main class teacher. If multiple appointments are made with the same teacher, the additional slots will be removed. We recommend that you allow a slot between each appointment, where possible.
- Please park in the upper school playground and make your way to our new Holyport Building where we ask you to please sign in and out. All appointments for this event will take place in the Holyport Building.

If you wish to speak to your child's Form Tutor, please telephone the school to speak with them directly. You will not be able to speak to them regarding Tutor issues on this evening. If you are unable to make an appointment with a staff member and have a particular need to see them, please contact that member of staff directly to make an alternative appointment.

Some of our Sixth Form students along with Mrs Luurtsema, Sixth Form Mentor, and Ms Kiely, Head of Sixth Form, will be available on this evening to answer any questions you may have regarding the various subjects on offer for Sixth Form study here at Cox Green School.
