As part of our ongoing drive to develop the needs and skills of our 11 students, Cox Green has designed a key stage 4 parent's workshop. The evening is an opportunity for parents to take part in a range of classroom based activities that show you skills and stresses that your son/daughter will be tackling throughout the academic year.

Activities will range from:

- Revision techniques
- Analysis of exam papers
- Question analysis

Staff from the Maths, English and Science department will be delivering bespoke activities that are based on the skills needed to tackle the upcoming examinations. The role of the parent/guardian over the coming months and the relationship with Cox Green School will be a critical reason for the success of your son/daughter. We hope that understanding these skills will enable you to relate to the ever changing GCSE curriculum and the new skills required for the 9-1 grade criteria.

The evening begins at 6.30pm in Dine@CoxGreen where you will be allocated to a group to begin a carousel of activities in each of the three subject areas. Each session will last 20 minutes with 5 minutes for questions and 5 minutes change over. Refreshments will be available.

At the end of each session the respective teachers will provide some information about the resources that are available to our students to support them in their learning outside of school as well as give some guidance on some of the strategies that students are encouraged to use both inside and outside of the classroom to help support their learning.
