Important Information about GCSE Results Day – Year 10- R.S

Congratulations to all of our students who have worked so hard in the lead up to their Religious Studies GCSE.

In light of the current situation and government guidelines on social distancing, students R.S GCSE result will be available on their EduLink account from 8am on Thursday 20th August. EduLink can be accessed via a web browser or the app. To support with government guidance, we are requesting that you **do not** attend school site unless invited to do so.

Students access EduLink using their normal school computer login – please can students ensure that they login into their EduLink account before results day to ensure that they can access their account. Any queries or problems with logging in should be sent to EduLink.help@coxgreen.com Please refer to our website for further information on how to access the results if required. If you do not have computer access, then please contact the school by the Thursday 16th July so an appointment can be arranged for you to collect your results.

If you have any questions on results day we have set up a dedicated e-mail address sixthform@coxgreen.com which will be monitored throughout the day. As we will have limited reception capacity on results day we ask that you use this email address rather than phoning the school. We do have staff available to support students with any wellbeing issues regarding their result and will offer support by phone and will contact you to make an appointment if needed.

We understand that, following results day, some students and parent/carers may have questions about the proposed exams in the Autumn for those who are unhappy with their grades. While the exam boards have not yet published a timetable for the individual subjects GCSE examinations will start on Monday 2 November and finish on Monday 23 November with the intention to provide results in Spring 2021. If you would like further information about the Autumn exams, please e-mail exams@coxgreen.com from 20th August. Our Exams Officer, Gwyneth Edwards, and subject teachers will be able to provide appropriate advice.

Finally, a reminder that certificates of exam results will be available from December 2020. Certificates are important legal documents – required for CVs, job applications and to verify the Statement of Results – and should be collected from the school main reception **by the student in person**. Uncollected certificates will be held in school for one year, after that time any uncollected certificates may be destroyed. Please keep certificates in a safe place as the school cannot provide replacements – they can be requested from the Exam boards at a cost of approximately £50.
