**RE: Year 12 Philosophy Webinar**

As you will be aware A-level Philosophy is a demanding subject and many of the support materials available are of varying quality and can be very costly. I am pleased to inform you that I have found a **webinar** on one of the two Year 12 modules which will be of great use to the students in their learning journeys. The webinar is on the topic of **Epistemology** which is the study of knowledge and how we know what we know. Michael Lacewing, (a well renowned A- level Philosophy teacher and examiner) who has published many books, and currently works at Christ Hospital School in Sussex, will be presenting the Webinar. We have used many of his resources during our studies to date, which will help students to develop their ideas further to access higher levels within the exam.

The webinar will take place on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March at 4.00 – 5.30pm in Cox Green School in room C4**. We will log on and use the interactive white board to be able to see and hear Michael present his PowerPoint presentation. There will also be opportunities for us to ask him questions about some of the more challenging topics, or to seek clarification on some of his ideas, which we may have encountered already in the course.

There is a **small fee for each student of £5** to attend the webinar. This is much cheaper than a revision conference and also removes any transport and travel implications. This is a very worthwhile opportunity which I would advise students to take full advantage of. Payment can be made using sQuid until 30th January.
