Dear Parents/Carers

Year 9 and 10 - Science in Action Trip - Monday 27 November 2023

We have arranged to take our Year 9 and 10 Science students to the Science in Action Lectures, at the Emmanuel Centre in London, on Monday 27 November 2023. This trip will engage students within Science and show them the wider applications of the subject and we strongly recommend attendance for those considering a future career in science. Students will experience interactive sessions, demonstrations, audience participation and a session on examination success to equip them with the tools to succeed.

The cost of this trip is £34.00 per student. There are 30 places available and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, via your child's sQuid account. Please make payment via your sQuid account and you will be able to do this from 7pm on Sunday 15 October 2023 (closing at 10pm on Wednesday 18 October 2023). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

As we anticipate this to be a high demand trip, we would advise parents/carers to log in to sQuid using a web browser rather than using the sQuid app. We have found that occasionally, certain phone models do not fully support the functionality of the sQuid app and parents/carers have struggled to complete the booking process. Please ensure you select the trip from the Trips/Offer Section, add the trip to your basket, agree to the Terms & Conditions, and then fully check out. Please ensure you select the correct offer for the year group your child is in.

We will travel to London by coach, departing Cox Green School at 8.30am and returning to school for approximately 4.30pm. We ask you to please arrange collection of your child accordingly at this time. Students are to wear full Cox Green School uniform on this trip and we ask that they bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day. Please note that in line with school policy, mobile phones are not allowed on any school trips.

If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.

Places on all trips are subject to the school Behaviour Policy. Any student who receives an internal or fixed term external suspension will have their place withdrawn from the trip and no refund will be made unless the place can be re-sold.
