Literacy Readers and Mentors Trip to Thorpe Park – Thursday 6 July 2023

We are delighted to invite students and mentors who have been part of our Literacy Programme, the opportunity to visit Thorpe Park on Thursday 6 July 2023.

Students and mentors have been selected based on attendance and those who have made excellent progress with their reading skills. These students have also shown their commitment to improving and demonstrating our school value of determination.

The cost of this subsidised trip is £15 per student and to book your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your sQuid account. This will be open from today (closing: 10pm on Monday 26 June 2023). Unfortunately, we are unable to offer a refund if your child is unable to attend on the day.

We will leave school at 9.00am and travel to Thorpe Park by coach, returning for 3.00pm. Students do not need to wear school uniform but should wear appropriate clothing and footwear suitable for this trip and weather conditions on the day. Students should bring with them a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day or money to purchase lunch and refreshments whilst at the venue. Please note, eating and drinking on the coach is not allowed.
