As we approach the Winter months, we wanted to share some general NHS health guidance with you.

Coughs and colds

It's fine to send your child to school with a minor <u>cough</u> or <u>common cold</u>, but if they have a fever, keep them off school until the fever goes.

Encourage your child to throw away any used tissues and to wash their hands regularly.

High temperature

If your child has a high temperature, keep them off school until it goes away.

COVID-19

If your child has mild symptoms, such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, and feels well enough, they can go to school.

Your child should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people if they have <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u> and they either have a high temperature, do not feel well enough to go to school or do their normal activities

Diarrhoea and/or vomiting

Children with <u>diarrhoea or vomiting</u> can return to school as soon as they have stopped being ill and they feel well enough.
