KS5 – Biology in Action – Tuesday 28 November 2023

We have arranged a fantastic opportunity to take our KS5 Biology students to the Biology in Action lectures, at the Emmanuel Centre in London, on Tuesday 28 November 2023. Five interactive and engaging sessions delivered by renowned scientists and communicators will inspire and motivate students. A special session with hints and tips for revision and examination success will provide students with the tools to succeed.

The cost of this trip is £22.50 per student. There are 30 places available on this trip and will be allocated on a first come first served basis by payment. To book your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your child's sQuid account which is open for payment from 6pm on Sunday 15 October 2023 (closing at 10pm on Tuesday 17 October). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

Students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 8.00am on the day, where they can purchase their travel ticket directly. The cost of this ticket is £35 (approx.) and we ask that students pay this directly on the day. We will then travel to the venue by train and tube, and expect to return to Maidenhead train station at approximately 5.45pm, and request you to arrange collection of your child accordingly. Should students wish to remain in London and make their own way home, please complete the permissions when prompted on your sQuid account. Students can wear smart casual wear on this trip and are to either bring their own lunch with them or money to purchase food during the day.
