Year 13 Government and Politics - Edexcel A Level Grade Booster Workshop - Tuesday 12 March 2024

I am writing to inform you that we have organised a cinema workshop trip on Tuesday 12 March 2024 for our A Level Politics students. This workshop takes place at the Vue Cinema, Cribbs Causeway, Bristol and is designed and delivered by experienced teachers and examiner presenters, all of whom have a deep understanding of what students need to focus on to succeed in the 2024 exams.

The workshop will provide revision sessions of each component of the course as well as provide opportunities for students to develop exam skills and techniques, including how to form model answers to the exam questions. The workshops will be hosted by the following presenters:

- Ciara McCombe – a leading Head of Politics with an expertise in the field of political language and theory
- Clive Owen – writer of key political textbooks and examiner
- Duncan Hall – writer of key political textbooks, academic political and social science articles, and a senior examiner.

We will travel to Bristol by minibus and students are to meet in Sixth Form at 8.00 am ahead of an 8.15am departure. We aim to return to school at 5.15 pm and we ask collection arrangements are made for this time. Students should bring a packed lunch, drinks and snacks to last the day, along with a notebook and pen.
