Dear Parents/Carers

Year 12 Trip to Brighton – Wednesday 10 July 2024

We would like to invite Year 12 students on a trip to Brighton on Wednesday 10 July 2024. This trip will be an opportunity for them to celebrate their first year as Sixth Form students at Cox Green School.

We will leave Cox Green School at 8.00am and travel to Brighton by coach; arriving back to school for 4.30pm. Please arrange drop off and arrange collection of your child accordingly. Students can wear casual clothing and shoes that are suitable for the beach and the weather conditions on the day.

We have arranged for students to have lunch together on the beach, provided by Harry Ramsden's, of either fish and chips or sausage and chips with a soft drink. Students will need to bring enough drinks and snacks to last the day or money to purchase them in Brighton. A reminder that eating food or chewing gum is not allowed on the coach and nuts or products containing nuts are strictly forbidden. Please confirm your child's lunch choice when prompted on sQuid, when making payment.

The cost of this trip is £24.00 per student which includes their coach travel and lunch. Places are offered on a first come, first served basis, by payment via your sQuid account. To secure your child's place, please make payment via your child's sQuid account, which will be open for payment from 6pm on Sunday 21 April 2024 (closing: 10pm on Sunday 5 May 2024). Students not attending this trip, are to attend school as normal.

Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
