Parent and Carers' Café:


Thursday 16th November: 9am—11am (Meet in School Reception)

### **Eton College Debates**

Eton College debaters returned to Cox Green School for their fourth in person session with Cox Green debaters. This was a very productive session that involved Year 10, 11 and 13 debaters from Cox Green who were focusing on the motion "This house believes that we should not eat meat." Arguments centred around environmental and ethical issues with excellent arguments, rebuttals and POIs (Points of Information) being raised. The next session in a week's time is going to look at the advantages vs disadvantages of Artificial Intelligence.

### Windsor Folio Trip—Year 13

On Thursday, Year 13 English Literature class visited Windsor Castle to visit the Folio400 presentation in the Royal Library. This amazing opportunity which gave the class a rare glimpse at the original book that was published 400 years ago in 1623 collecting together almost all of William Shakespeare's known plays. They could look at pages of Othello (their set text), Macbeth (their GCSE text) and Romeo and Juliet (a perennial favourite). The Royal Librarian talked to them about various monarch's passion for the bard. They looked at a signed copy of the Second Folio that Charles I had studied when he was in captivity at Windsor Castle prior to his execution. As the students are examined on context for their A Level exams this visit proved invaluable. A rare opportunity that was enjoyed by all. Thank you to Mrs Leary for her support with the trip.
