Year 10 Talk on Raising Awareness of Testicular Cancer by The OddBalls Foundation

Our Science curriculum for Year 10 covers non-communicable diseases and more specifically cancer. To complement this area of study, we have invited a few individuals from The OddBalls Foundation to come in to speak to students about Testicular Cancer on Monday 24th April 2023.

The OddBalls talk focuses on raising awareness of Testicular Cancer, breaking down the stigma associated with people talking openly about their testicles and encouraging people to check themselves regularly. The talk is approximately 25 minutes long and appropriate for all genders. The talk is engaging, informal and gets people thinking about important health issues from a less serious perspective.

The talk covers the basics of Testicular Cancer, such as the signs & symptoms, possible risk factors, how to check correctly, diagnosis, treatment, the importance of support networks and who to speak to about any concerns.
