**Re: Year 11 Study Leave**

As you are aware the exam season is fast approaching and staff and students are working incredibly hard to ensure all students reach their full potential.

GCSE summer exams will take place from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May until Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June inclusive. Individual exam timetables are available on EduLink for all students to view.

We have discussed what is best for students regarding study leave and a decision has been made that from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May, students can opt-in to attend school for those who wish to continue with their revision on school site. During these 2 weeks, students will be following their normal timetable with a focus on revision when they are not in their GCSE exams. For those who wish to revise at home there is no expectation for them to attend school when they do not have an exam. Please note that students who opt for revision in school will be expected to commit to attending until the end of term on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May.

Study leave for all Year 11 students will begin immediately after the May half term, at which point all students should only come into school to attend their exams.

This period of time is very important and can often make a real difference to a students' exam performance, so I very much welcome your support on this matter by ensuring that your son/daughter uses this period of study leave productively whether it is at home or at school.
