**Year 12 and 13 BTEC Health and Social Care Trip
Unit 1 - Grade Booster - Wednesday 3 May 2023**

I am writing to inform you that we have organised a trip to London on Wednesday 3 May 2023 for our BTEC Health and Social Care students for a cinema workshop. This workshop takes place at the Vue Cinema, Westfield, White City and is designed and delivered by experienced teacher and examiner presenters, of all whom have a deep understanding of what students need to focus on in order to succeed in the 2023 exams.

The workshop will be delivered in four sessions by specialist presenters and covers the following:

- Session 1: Success in short answer questions and interpreting data
- Session 2: Health and social care language
- Session 3: Theories and models revision blast
- Session 4: Nailing the 10 mark questions.

The cost for this event is £35.60 per student and we ask you to please make payment via your child's sQuid account which is now open for payment (closing 10pm on Thursday 27 April 2023). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to attend.

We will travel to London by train and students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 8.00am where we ask students to purchase their train ticket directly on the day. We aim to return to Maidenhead train station at 5.10pm and we ask collection arrangements are made for this time. Students are advised to bring a packed lunch, drinks and snacks to last the day.
