KS5 – Chemistry in Action – Wednesday 7 December 2022

We have arranged a fantastic opportunity to take our KS5 Chemistry students to the Chemistry in Action lectures, at the Emmanuel Centre in London, on Wednesday 7 December 2022. Five sessions of leading chemists in academia and industry will inspire the scientists of the future.

Science comedian Steve Cross will chair the event, which also includes a special session on examination success that will ensure students are equipped with the tools to excel. There will be plenty of interactivity throughout the day, with polls, quizzes and the chance to question the scientists.

The cost of this trip is £22.50 and to book your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your child's sQuid account which is now open for payment (closing at 10pm on Sunday 30 October 2022). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

Students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 8.00am on the day, where they can purchase their travel ticket directly. The cost of this ticket is £20 (approx.) and we ask that students pay this directly on the day. We will then travel to the venue by train and tube, and expect to return to Maidenhead train station at approximately 5.45pm, and request you to arrange collection of your child accordingly. Should students wish to remain in London and make their own way home, please complete the permissions when prompted on your sQuid account. Students can wear smart casual wear on this trip and are to either bring their own lunch with them or money to purchase food during the day.

Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
