Well done to all involved!

Last weekend, nine of our students from Years 8-12 competed in the Berkshire Schools Track and Field Championships at Palmer Park in Reading. These students qualified at the District trials and were competing for a place in the County Team.

All students were a credit to the school and had some excellent results and I am delighted to announce that Imogen Wilson in Y12 has now qualified for the 400m at English Schools. 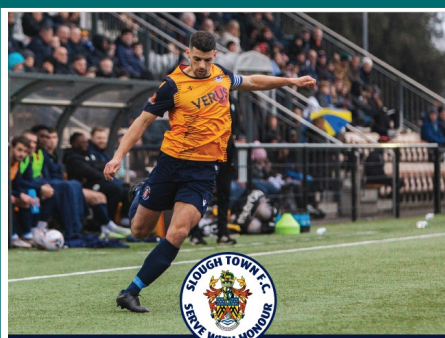
