Compulsory Year 10 and 11 CGSE Drama Trip – Tuesday 16 January 2024 **Blood Brothers, New Victoria Theatre, Woking**

As part of your child's GCSE Drama course, we have organised a trip to see an evening performance of Blood Brothers. This is a compulsory trip and is essential to the curriculum and completion of the syllabus being studied. All GCSE Drama students must attend due to the nature of the course, as they will be answering questions about the live performance in exam conditions.

The cost of this trip is £33.55 per student, and we ask you to please make payment via your sQuid account to secure your child's place. sQuid is now open for payment and will close at 10pm on Tuesday 12 December 2023. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

We would advise parents/carers to log in to sQuid using a web browser rather than using the sQuid app. We have found that occasionally, certain phone models do not fully support the functionality of the sQuid app and parents/carers have struggled to complete the booking process. Please ensure you select the trip from the Trips/Offer Section, add the trip to your basket, agree to the Terms & Conditions, and then fully check out. Please ensure you select the correct offer for the year group your child is in.

We will travel to Woking by coach, departing Cox Green School at 5.30pm and returning to school for approximately 10.30pm. Students can wear their own appropriate clothing on this trip and may wish to bring a drink or snack for the interval, or money to purchase refreshments at the venue. Please note that eating is not permitted on the coach.

- Places on all trips are subject to the school Behaviour Policy.
