## Picking Options – Online Portal



- To submit their choices your child will need to login to their school email account at <a href="https://mail.google.com/">https://mail.google.com/</a> using their email and their school password.
- In their emails they will receive an email from noreply@sims.co.uk which has an invite link and code.
- Your child will need to create an account on Sims Options Online using this link and we suggest they
  use the "external" account button then login with their School Google Mail account.
- Once logged in, students should complete their Options choices, selecting 4 options and one reserve, ensuring they change these options into the correct priority order on the right side of the screen.
- Press the **save button** at the top left to save your choices.
- We do require parental approval which means you will then need to login with your account details, approve the choices and submit.
- Parents will also receive the same email to the email account they have registered with the school.
- Following the same process above, registering with your own email address with Sims Option Online, and tick the "Parental Approval" box to verify you are happy with the choices your child has made on the form.
