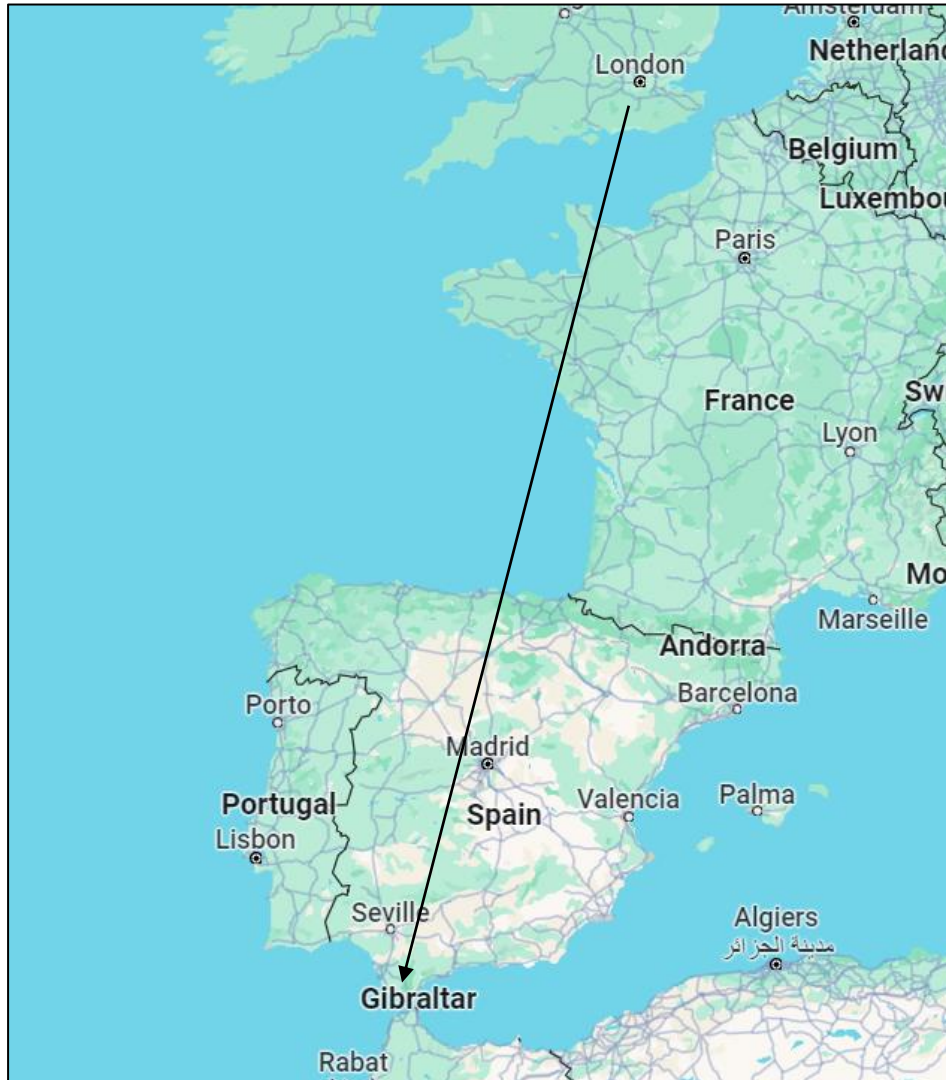
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Where are we going?

- **Staff will be located nearby**



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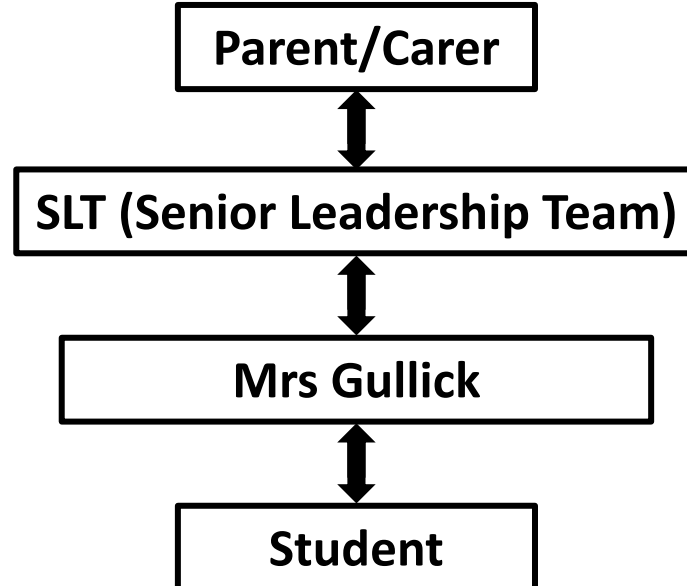
Spending Money/Valuables/Passports

- **Spending money will need to be exchanged for the Euro prior to the trip (Sterling for UK)**
- **Students will hold onto their own money**
- **Passports and E/GHIC's will be collected and held by a member of staff during travel**
- **Students are advised against taking any valuable items
- lost or stolen items cannot be replaced by the school**
- **Mobile phones/cameras may be taken (at own risk) for taking photos, but due to GDPR, students are NOT to upload anything/images to social media**



Emergency Contact

- **Phone the school in the first instance during office hours**
- **If outside of office hours, please use the emergency number**
(this will be provided the week of the trip)
- **Students are not to contact home directly**



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Cont.

- **Contact details – in case of emergency, we shall use your child’s Priority 1 contact, as confirmed on the most recent OA4 form that you returned to school
(copy in your envelopes)**
- **Check these details are accurate - these are the details used should we need to contact you**
- **Please clearly mark any amendments and return to Mrs Feetham, by this coming Thursday, 22 February, or hand in now before you leave**



Medication

- **Please complete the ‘Residential Trip – Medicine Form’ for any medication your child will require during the time of this trip (this applies to both prescribed and over-the-counter medicine)**
- **Any medication is to be handed in to Mrs Feetham by Friday 1 March, in original boxes and clearly labelled Only provide enough medication for the duration of the trip.**
- **We will only hold onto medication listed on the Residential Trip - Medicine Form**
- **Students are NOT to carry any medication (except for inhalers or Auto-Injectors)**



Rooming requests

- **Students to complete Rooming Request slips (in your envelopes) and return to Mrs Feetham by this coming Thursday, 22 February.**
- **We will aim for students to share with at least one of their nominations (but this is not guaranteed).**



Luggage allowance

Checked baggage allowance – one piece weighing up to 23kg

Hand baggage allowance – one piece measuring no more than 40x30x15cm (including the handle, pockets and wheels)

Please note airline liquid allowance

Each liquid must be in its own container of no more than 100ml (3.4oz). You need to put all items in a single, transparent, re-sealable plastic bag of up to 20 x 20cm (8 x 8in) with a total capacity of up to one litre (approx. one quart).

Students must be able to carry their own luggage!

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What to take?

- **Your own passport and E/GHIC**
- **Toiletries**
- **Clothing – please pack appropriate clothing**
- **Beach wear and beach towel**
 - **Warm jumper/fleece and coat/rain jacket**
- **Sensible/comfortable footwear for walking**
- **Suncream/sun hat**
- **Refillable water bottle**
