Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been advised that there are works programmed to take place along Highfield Lane for approximately four weeks, which started yesterday. The work includes excavation and subsequent reinstatement of the carriageway, footpath and verge for the installation of a High Voltage Electric Cable. There will be temporary traffic lights in place at times so please be mindful that traffic may be slower than normal and please do allow sufficient time for your school journey throughout this period.

I am always pleased to hear about students excelling at school but also in their extra-curricular events and hobbies, so I was delighted to hear about Caden Lawson (Year 7) and his excellent performance last weekend at the Maidenhead Athletics Sportshall Final. I am also so proud of each of the 36 students who participated in the Swimarathon last weekend and swam 838 lengths (just under 21km!). Each and everyone of them encapsulated our School Values and have currently raised over £1500 in sponsorship which will be split between Alexander Devine Children's Hospice and Maidenhead Lions. They have also been awarded the President's Cup for the 'team which most epitomises the ethos of the event' and an additional £200 to their fundraising which is outstanding recognition for their efforts and commitment. To do this is in a period where people have so much expense and high bills is even more impressive and each of them will be awarded 50 positive points in recognition of their efforts.
