**Sixth Form Compulsory Trip
Safe Drive Stay Alive - Tuesday 22 November 2022**

We are inviting all our Sixth Form students to attend the afternoon stage production of the Safe Drive Stay Alive campaign at The Anvil Centre in Basingstoke, on Tuesday 22 November 2022. This production is free to students, as it is subsidised by Thames Valley Police and Cox Green School.

This campaign is aimed at those students who are about to start to learn to drive or have recently passed their test. It is designed to raise awareness of how young people can be safer on the roads - whether they are drivers, passengers or cyclists. Those affected by road collisions give personal testimonies including emergency service staff, hospital staff, victims and parents and friends of victims. For this reason, it is compulsory all our Sixth Form students attend this event.

We shall leave Cox Green School at 11.30am and travel by coach to Basingstoke, returning to school for 4.00pm and we ask you to please make arrangements for the collection of your child at this time. Counsellors will be present at the Safe Drive event should your child be affected by the material shared. Please contact Miss Langford-Thomas if you have any concerns. Linked to this, as more and more students take up driving lessons, they should plan these lessons to be taken outside of school hours.
