### **Food Share Partnership: Olio**

We are pleased to announce that the school and our caterers, Innovate, have joined a Food Share Partnership called Olio.

Olio launched in 2015 and is the UK's major local sharing app. Olio works by local Food Hero Volunteers collecting food that would otherwise go to waste and redistributing to local families in need of support.

The partnership with Innovate and Olio helps us to tackle and reduce food waste, protect the environment and help local families.

### **E-Scooters**

It is illegal to ride a privately owned electric scooter in public. That is because e-scooters are classed as motor vehicles in law.

So, in theory, this means that you need an MOT, road tax and insurance to use one, however it isn't currently possible to register e-scooters in this way. Privately owned e-scooters can only be used on private land, with the permission of the landowner. You cannot use a privately owned e-scooter on the road, pavement or in a public space. If you do then you risk receiving a large fine, points on your driving licence and your e-scooter could be seized. Some parts of the UK are running government trials of rental e-scooters. If you're over 16 and have a full or provisional driving licence, then you can use these on public roads and cycle paths. Just check that your driving licence covers categories AM, A or B.
