Re: Year 13 Study Leave

As you are aware the exam season is fast approaching and staff and students are working incredibly hard to ensure all students reach their full potential.

A-level and BTEC summer exams will take place from Monday 15th May until Wednesday 28th June inclusive. Individual exam timetables are available on EduLink for all students to view.

We have discussed what is best for students regarding study leave and a decision has been made that from Monday 15th May to Friday 26th May, students can opt-in to attend school for those who wish to continue to attend their lessons. Students will have to sign in when they arrive at school and sign out when they leave. For those who wish to revise at home there is no expectation for them to attend school when they do not have an exam. Please note that students who opt for school revision on-site will be expected to commit to attending their lessons until the end of term on Friday 26th May.

Please click [here](#) to advise us whether your child will still be attending school or revising at home before Thursday 11th May. Study leave for all Year 13 students will begin immediately after the May half term, at which point all students should only come into school to attend their exams.

This period of time is very important and can often make a real difference to a students' exam performance, so I very much welcome your support on this matter by ensuring that your son/daughter uses this period of study leave productively whether it is at home or at school.
