Important Changes to Free School Meals (FSM)

In September 2026, the government will be changing the eligibility criteria for Free School Meals (FSM)

All current FSM eligibility will end.

All families must re-apply or lose their FSM allowance.

More families will now be eligible, including everyone who receives Universal Credit.

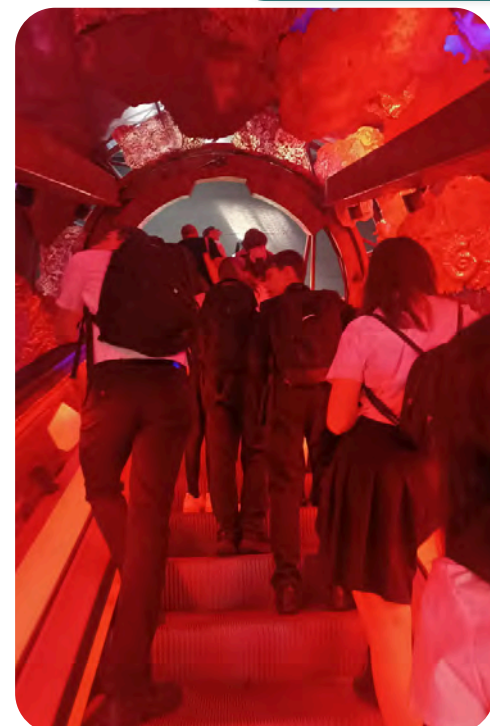

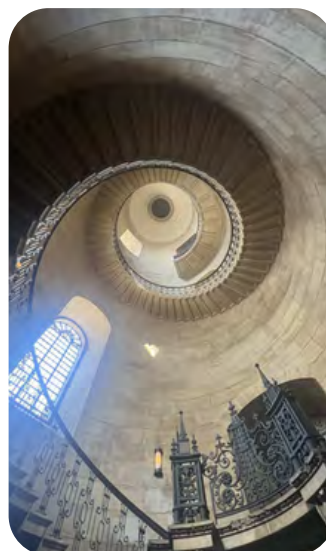
