**Compulsory Theatre Trip – Wednesday 17 April 2024**  
**Standing at the Sky's Edge, Gillian Lynne Theatre, London**  
**Year 13 Theatre Studies and Year 12 Performing Arts BTEC Students**

As part of your child's course, we have organised a trip to see a matinee performance of *Standing at the Sky's Edge*. This is a compulsory trip and all students must attend due to the nature of the course, as Year 13 students will be answering questions about the live performance in exam conditions and Year 12 students are required to watch live theatre as part of their qualification.

The ticket cost of this trip is £25.50 per student, and we ask you to please make payment via your sQuid account to secure your child's place. sQuid will be open for payment at 6pm on Monday 18 March and will close at 10pm on Thursday 21 March 2024. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

We would advise parents/carers to log in to sQuid using a web browser rather than using the sQuid app. We have found that occasionally, certain phone models do not fully support the functionality of the sQuid app and parents/carers have struggled to complete the booking process. Please ensure you select the trip from the Trips/Offer Section, add the trip to your basket, agree to the Terms & Conditions, and then fully check out. Please ensure you select the correct offer for the year group your child is in.

We will travel to London by train, departing Cox Green School at 11.30am and travel to Maidenhead train station by school minibus, and we ask students to purchase their rail tickets on the day. Students are to attend Period 1 and 2 lessons as normal. Students can wear their own appropriate clothing on this trip and should bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day or money to purchase refreshments on the day.

Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
