
Dear Parents and Carers,
















Please note the school will be closed for INSET day on Friday 5th December. School will re-open on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> December for all year groups.

### **Access to the Buildings:**

Please be aware that the Cookham Building is now access controlled, and students are only permitted to enter during lesson times (8:30 am – 3:00 pm).

This measure has been introduced because the building is not fully supervised outside of these hours, and we want to ensure student safety at all times.

If your child needs to visit Reception or Finance before school, they will need to enter through the main front entrance between 8:15am – 8:30 am, where appropriate supervision is in place.

We are supporting Foodshare Maidenhead.




