Student Services. If your child becomes unwell during the school day and contacts you directly, please ask them to come to Student Services for support. This is important to ensure their safety and wellbeing, while contact home is made.

Reporting Student Absence

It is imperative that parents/carers contact the school before 8.00am if their child is unwell and unable to attend school, on each day of absence.

Any absences that we have not received a reason for within a reasonable timeframe, will be followed up and the Attendance Officer will proceed to call all contacts that we hold on your child's record. For safeguarding purposes, if we have not managed to make contact then members of staff will visit your home to ensure the welfare of your child. All leave of absence is recorded on your child's school file.

Medical Appointments:

Whilst some appointments may have to take place during the school day, e.g. specific scheduled hospital appointments, there are other appointments that could take place outside of school hours. It is expected that students are only out of school for the actual appointment and are therefore able to attend before and/or after in order to allow minimum disruption to their lessons and attendance. Term time absences should be reported at least 24 hours before with supporting documents, such as a medical appointment card.

iPay Automatic Top Ups

iPay have introduced a new option, for automatic top-up of your child's School Meal account only when the balance falls below a chosen amount. To use this function, log into your iPay account via the app or the website:

- From the Homepage, select your child's account
- Select School Meals
- Select Edit automatic payment
- Under Regularity, select Top-Up Top-up once a balance threshold is met
- Enter a start date, the threshold at which you want the automatic top-up to be applied, and the amount of the automatic top-up
- Select your payment method
- Then click Activate, Confirm & Continue
- To check you have set it up, you can click on the 'Automatic Payments' icon on your Homepage

Please note that as the automatic top-up can take up to 12 hours to be applied, you may wish to set the threshold at £10 to ensure that you child always has sufficient funds to purchase food.


