Last week, seven courageous Year 12 students set off on their DofE Gold assessment expedition in the wild and rugged landscapes of North Wales—an adventure that tested their endurance, resilience, and spirit. Starting in Bethesda, the group trekked deep into the dramatic Carneddau mountains, spending a night wild camping under the stars. Despite the intense summer heat, the students handled the conditions superbly—waking on Sunday morning to witness a breath taking sunrise over the peaks, a moment of calm before the challenge ahead. On Monday, the group moved to the base of Snowdon, ready to take on the formidable Watkin Path. With determination and teamwork, they made a strong ascent, reaching high above the clouds and soaking in the stunning views whenever the mist gave way. But the mountains had one final test in store. As evening arrived, the weather turned dramatically—driving rain and high winds battered their final wild camp. Undeterred, the group showed true Gold-level grit and resilience, pushing through the storm to successfully complete their expedition on Tuesday. Throughout the journey, students demonstrated excellent camp craft, from pitching tents in wild terrain to cooking meals in all conditions—a testament to their preparation and perseverance. 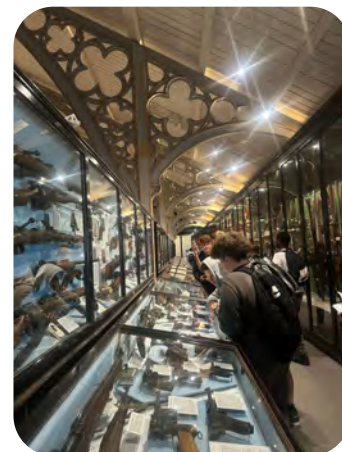
