GCSE and A Level Music Trip to 'Into The Woods' Wednesday 28 January 2026 – The Bridge Theatre, London

As part of the GCSE and A-level music courses, students study musical theatre and to help them to get the best form of understanding is to experience a live performance. We are, therefore, delighted to invite your child to attend an evening performance of Into The Woods at the Bridge Theatre in London on Wednesday 28 January 2026.

Experiencing this musical is the perfect opportunity for students to see how a large-scale professional performance works and how the music enhances the emotion of the piece. The music is by Stephen Sondheim who is a key composer for our A-level music course, where students delve into the complexities of his writing. For our GCSE students they will look at aspects of the composers' work, and Into the Woods could be used as an unfamiliar listening piece for Component 3 – Appraisal.

The cost of this trip is £42.60 and to confirm your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your child's iPay account. iPay is open for payment now and will close at 10pm on Sunday 2 November.

Students are to return back to school for 4.30pm where we will then travel to London by coach, returning for 12.30am (TBC) and we ask you to make collection arrangements for your child at this time. The dress code for this theatre trip is smart-casual (tracksuits and short tops/skirts are not allowed). Students may wish to bring a water bottle and a snack or money to purchase refreshments at the venue. As a reminder no nuts or foods containing nuts are allowed. Return time to school will be confirmed once the performance end time is finalised. Students are expected to be in school as normal the following morning.

Please note:

- Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met. Any student who receives a suspension may have their place withdrawn from the trip and no refund will be made unless the place can be resold. Support for non-compulsory curriculum trips is limited to 25% of the total cost of the trip. Support for non-curriculum trips will vary. Sixth Form: You may be eligible for assistance with the cost of this trip with a 16-19 Bursary.

- If your child receives free school meals and you would like a packed lunch provided for your child for this trip, please email enquiries@coxgreen.com, for the attention of the Trip Administrator, at least 5 schools days before the date of the trip to request this (please detail any dietary requirements).
- Payments are to be made by the dates specified. Late or non-payment may result in your child's place being withdrawn from the trip. If you choose to withdraw your child for reasons not stated above, any costs attributed to date, must still be made.
- Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
- There will be no insurance cover due to disinclination to travel.
