Year 13 Psychology Trip to the Freud Museum – Wednesday 21 January 2026

We have arranged an amazing opportunity for our Year 13 Psychology students to visit the Freud Museum in London on Wednesday 21 January 2026.

This trip will give students a valuable insight into the inner life and workings of Sigmund Freud's approach to psychology. He pioneered the use of psychoanalysis in treatment which is still be used today. This visit will give students a broader understanding of his practices, as well as allowing them to understand the context of the rest of his life within the scope of world wars, his work with women, and the legacy left by him and his daughter, Anna. Freud is a crucial part of the biological psychology topic at A-Level, and this trip will enhance the understanding of his aforementioned work, as well as his explanations for aggression.

The cost of this trip is £12.70 per student, and we ask you to please make payment via your iPay account to secure your child's place. iPay is now open for payment and will close at 10pm on Wednesday 17 December 2025. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

We will travel to London by train and students are to meet me at Maidenhead Train Station at 9.00am where we ask them to purchase their own travel tickets. Please complete permission questions when purchasing your child's place on iPay regarding permission to remain in London (students will be able to contact parents for collection time when known).

The dress code for this trip is casual. Students may wish to bring a packed lunch, snacks and drink to last the day or money to purchase refreshments whilst in London. As a reminder no nuts or foods containing nuts are allowed.

Please note:

- Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met. - Payments are to be made by the dates specified. Late or non-payment may result in your child's place being withdrawn from the trip. If you choose to withdraw your child for reasons not stated above, any costs attributed to date, must still be made.
- Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
