Dear Parents/Carers

Year 13 Sociology Trip - AQA A-Level Grade Booster Workshop

I am writing to inform you that we have organised a cinema workshop trip on Thursday 26 March 2026 for our A Level Sociology students. This workshop takes place at the Vue Cinema, Westfield, White City in London and is designed and delivered by experienced teacher and examiner presenters, all of whom have a deep understanding of what students need to focus on to succeed in the 2026 exams.

The workshop will provide revision sessions of each component of the course as well as provide opportunities for students to develop exam skills and techniques, including how to form model answers to the exam questions. The workshops will be hosted by the following presenters:

- Anna Lise White – an experienced Sociology teacher
- Craig Gelling - an experienced A Level and GCSE Sociology teacher, examiner, author and presenter
- Duncan Hall - an experienced Social Science and Humanities teacher, writer and senior examiner, who has taught Politics and Sociology A Level for many years and has a PhD in Social History
- Katie Tyler - an experienced Sociology teacher and examiner.

The ticket cost of this trip is £36.60 and we ask that you please make payment via your child's iPay account which is now open for payment (closing at 10pm on Sunday 18 January 2026). Unfortunately, we are unable to purchase and secure tickets with the venue until student payments and numbers are confirmed. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to attend.

We will travel to London by train and students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 7.45am where we ask students to purchase their train ticket directly on the day. We aim to return to Maidenhead train station at 5.00pm and we ask collection arrangements are made for this time. Students should bring a packed lunch, drinks and snacks to last the day, along with a notebook and pen.

- *Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met.
