The ticket cost of this trip is £26 and we ask that you please make payment via your child's iPay account which is now open for payment (closing at 10pm on Wednesday 4 February 2026). Unfortunately, we are unable to purchase and secure tickets with the venue until student payments and numbers are confirmed. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to attend. Please ensure you select the trip from your iPay account and fully check out to secure your child's place.

Students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 9.00am on the day, where we ask them to purchase their travel ticket directly. We will then travel to the venue by train, and expect to return to Maidenhead train station at approximately 5.15pm (please arrange collection of your child accordingly). Should students wish to remain in London and make their own way home, please complete the permissions when prompted on your iPay account. Students can wear smart casual clothes on this trip and are to bring a notebook and pen, along with their own lunch or money to purchase food during the day (please note: products containing nuts are not allowed).

Please note:

- *Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met. Any student who receives a suspension may have their place withdrawn from the trip and no refund will be made unless the place can be resold. If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
