Dear Parents/Carers

Year 10 GCSE Compulsory Geography Field Trip to Brighton – Wednesday 8 July 2026

As part of the GCSE Geography course, students are to complete one day of compulsory fieldwork in order to experience 'practical geography' and have hands on experience of collecting and processing data, in order to come to a substantiated conclusion to answer an enquiry question.

It has become a tradition for our Geography students to visit Brighton for their field trip, as this provides an ideal location to study coastal processes as well as human impacts in the town. Students will be divided into groups with a staff member, to complete data collection at various sites.

The cost of this compulsory trip is £15.00 and to confirm your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your iPay account, which is now open for payment (closing: 10pm on Wednesday 13 May 2026).

We will leave school at 8.00am and travel to Brighton by coach, returning for 4.00pm. Please arrange drop off and collection of your child for these times. Students should wear appropriate clothing and footwear suitable for the coast and weather conditions on the day (including being on the beach). Students should bring with them a full pencil case, including pencils as they will be drawing, along with a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day (a reminder that nuts or products containing nuts are not allowed). Students may wish to bring some money as there may be an opportunity to have some free time after lunch, before returning. Please note, eating and drinking on the coach is not allowed.

All Year 10 GCSE Geography students are expected to attend this compulsory element, and if you have any questions or queries in the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Please note:

- *Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met. Any student who receives a suspension may have their place withdrawn from the trip and no refund will be made unless the place can be resold. In addition, if the school assesses that the attendance on a trip is a Health and Safety risk to the student or to others, a place will not be allocated to that student or a place will be withdrawn and there will be no refund made unless the place can be resold.*
 - *Should your child be unable to attend a trip due to medical reasons, we will require a Medical Certificate to apply for an insurance claim.*
 - *If your child is, or has ever been, in receipt of free school meals, then you may be eligible for assistance with the cost of this trip:
Years 7-11: Pupil Premium funding for trips is to be used for educational purposes only. Support for non-compulsory trips will vary.
Sixth Form: You may be eligible for assistance with the cost of this trip with a 16-19 Bursary.*
- All requests for assistance should be made to the Finance Office (finance@coxgreen.com) at least 5 school days before the trip opens on iPay.**
- *If your child receives free school meals and you would like a packed lunch provided for your child for this trip, please email enquiries@coxgreen.com for the attention of the Trip Administrator, at least 5 school days before the date of the trip to request this (please detail any dietary requirements).*
 - *Payments are to be made by the dates specified. Late or non-payment may result in your child's place being withdrawn from the trip. If you choose to withdraw your child for reasons not stated above, any costs attributed to date, must still be made.*
 - *Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.*
 - *There will be no insurance cover due to disinclination to travel.*
