**Year 12 Performing Arts BTEC trip – Monday 1 June 2026**  
**‘The Playboy of the Western World’ – Maidenhead Odeon Cinema**

As part of your child’s BTEC Performing Arts course, we have organised a trip to see an evening cinema version of ‘The Playboy of the Western World’. This is a cinema screening of the live performance performed at The National.

To support their BTEC Performing Arts Level 3 course, it is highly recommended that students watch a variety of live or pre-recorded performances throughout their course. Attending this performance will widen their knowledge and experience of theatre, especially as this is a production from The National Theatre.

The cost of this trip is £31.85 per student, and we ask you to please make payment via your iPay account to secure your child’s place. iPay is now open for payment and will close at 10pm on Wednesday 13 May 2026. Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to go.

Students are to make their own drop off and collection arrangements and to meet me at the front of the cinema on the evening at 7.00pm. The performance is advertised at commencing at 7.15pm and we therefore anticipate a collection time of around 9.00-9.15pm (but this is dependent on the actual start time of the screening).

**Please note:**

- *Places on all trips are subject to the school expectations for the Behaviour Policy being met. Any student who receives a suspension may have their place withdrawn from the trip and no refund will be made unless the place can be resold. - *Payments are to be made by the dates specified. Late or non-payment may result in your child’s place being withdrawn from the trip. If you choose to withdraw your child for reasons not stated above, any costs attributed to date, must still be made.*
- *Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.*
- *There will be no insurance cover due to disinclination to travel.*
