

- Staff will be located nearby








## **Spending Money/Valuables/Passports**

- Spending money will need to be exchanged for the Euro prior to the trip (Sterling for UK)
- Students will hold onto their own money
- Passports and E/GHIC's will be collected and held by a member of staff during travel
- Students are advised against taking any valuable items
  - lost or stolen items cannot be replaced by the school
- Mobile phones/cameras may be taken (at own risk) for taking photos, but due to GDPR, students are NOT to upload anything/images to social media



- Phone the school in the first instance during office hours
- If outside of office hours, please use the emergency number (this will be provided the week of the trip)
- Students are not to contact home directly





- Contact details in case of emergency, we shall use your child's Priority 1 contact, as confirmed on the most recent OA4 form that you returned to school (copy in your envelopes)
- Check these details are accurate these are the details used should we need to contact you
- Please clearly mark any amendments and return to Mrs Feetham, by this coming Thursday, 22 February, or hand in now before you leave



- Please complete the 'Residential Trip Medicine Form' for any medication your child will require during the time of this trip (this applies to both prescribed and over-the-counter medicine)
- Any medication is to be handed in to Mrs Feetham by
   <u>Friday 1 March, in original boxes and clearly labelled</u> Only
   provide enough medication for the duration of the trip.
- We will only hold onto medication listed on the Residential Trip - Medicine Form
- Students are NOT to carry any medication (except for inhalers or Auto-Injectors)



- Students to complete Rooming Request slips
   (in your envelopes) and return to Mrs Feetham by this coming Thursday, 22 February.
- We will aim for students to share with at least one of their nominations (but this is not guaranteed).



Checked baggage allowance – one piece weighing up to 23kg

Hand baggage allowance – one piece measuring no more than 40x30x15cm (including the handle, pockets and wheels)

#### Please note airline liquid allowance

Each liquid must be in its own container of no more than 100ml (3.4oz). You need to put all items in a single, transparent, re-sealable plastic bag of up to  $20 \times 20 \text{cm}$  (8 x 8in) with a total capacity of up to one litre (approx. one quart).

Students must be able to carry their own luggage!

   Warm jumper/fleece and coat/rain jacket
- Sensible/comfortable footwear for walking
- Suncream/sun hat
