
Dear Parents and Carers.



- Upgrade to the Wi-Fi and networking infrastructure
- Renewal of paint decoration to the whole school
- Replacement of the carpet to entranceways
- Installation of further access controls and security upgrades
- Renewal and patching of building roofs
- 2 x IT Suites upgraded with new computers
- Installation of even more interactive screens for lessons
- New equipment for Food Tech including washing machine, compost bins and large freezer

Our site team have been working hard over the summer holiday completing important refurbishments to the school site to improve the facilities for our school community.

One of the team's larger projects included major works and changes to the Bisham and Fifield buildings; moving the Hub, SAFE and SENCo offices to Bisham, and creating a dedicated literacy support room in Fifield. The office rebuilds took place over several weeks, but have resulted in larger, more efficient office space and facilities that directly benefit the students.

Our students and staff were also thrilled to return to school to see upgrades to the Theatre, including 2 x display screens increasing visibility for performances and a new laser projector.

A huge thank you to all of our colleagues in the Site Team for all your hard work and effort over the holidays.
