This week, you may be aware of the recent updated guidance from the Food Standards Agency regarding the recall and investigation of products containing mustard, mustard powder and mustard flour, as these ingredients may have been contaminated with peanuts. Until further notice, we are advising all students with a nut allergy to avoid any products from the canteen that contain these ingredients. If your child has a nut allergy, please encourage them to speak to the catering team for help checking the allergens.
