Important Changes to Free School Meals (FSM)

In September 2026, the government will be changing the eligibility criteria for Free School Meals (FSM)

All current FSM eligibility will end. All families must re-apply or lose their FSM allowance.

More families will now be eligible, including everyone who receives Universal Credit.

iPayimpact

iPayimpact will be undergoing an update over the course of July.

The update will involve the following:

Any saved card details held in iPayimpact will be removed. You will need to re-enter your card details.

Any automatic payments will be paused until you add a new card and re-apply it to your automatic payment settings.

The checkout screen will look slightly different, but all features remain the same.

Apple Pay or Google Pay are not affected.

Refunds continue to work as normal, including for payments made before the update.

You will receive communication directly from iPay when the update is completed, and banners will appear in the app and website to guide you through any actions needed. 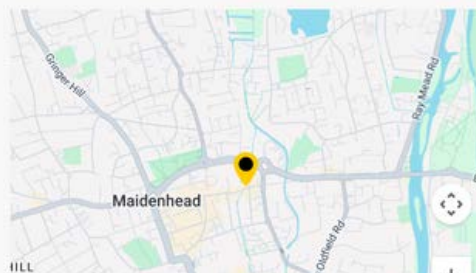

including badminton and catching up with friends before the summer holiday.

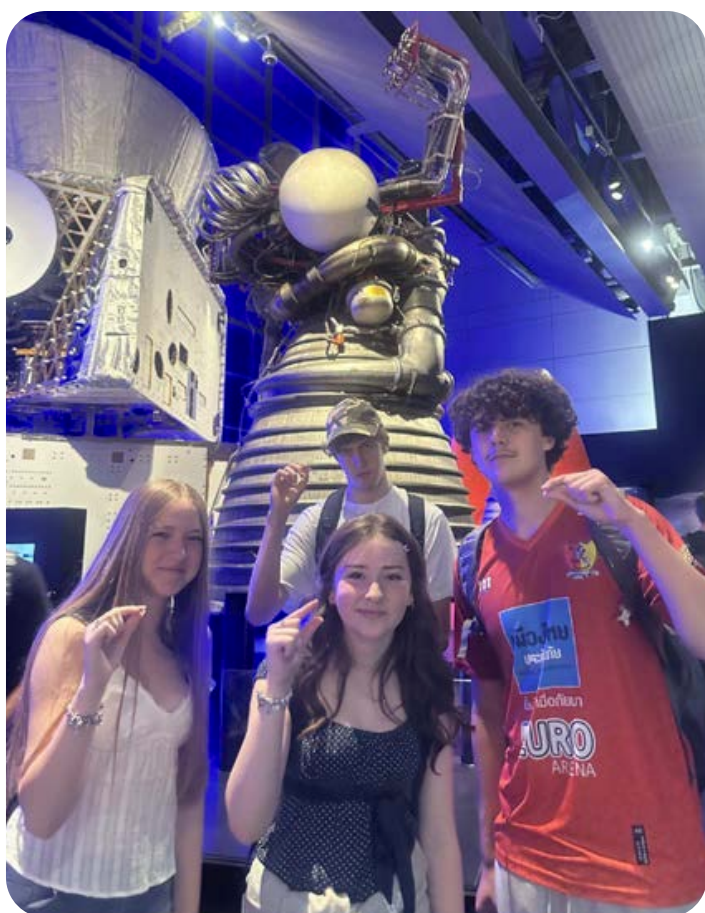
