Sixth Form News



In their assemblies this week, Year 10 and 11 have been visited by Mr Burrows, who has spoken about Cox Green Sixth Form and post 16 options. Mr Burrows talked through the three different pathways available to the students and provided an overview of the subject choices. Cox Green School presents a unique offer to all our students. It is the only local Sixth Form where you can study all three Science A Levels alongside one another, and one of the only in the borough to offer highly regarded courses such as Philosophy, and Government and Politics. Vitally, Cox Green is one of the few Sixth Form centres that offer students the option to choose a blended pathway for their post 16 study; where students can choose a mix of A-Level and BTEC options to make up their course, which importantly, for some students offers the chance to pursue coaching opportunities at the Sports Academy alongside their A-Level options.

Our Sixth Form prospectus is now live on the website and you can view the options and courses available for 2025 entry. The Sixth Form page also has student profiles where you can hear from our current and past students about life and opportunities in Year 12 & 13!

All students in Year 11 who meet the entrance criteria and demonstrate commitment to their academic work are entitled to a place in the Sixth Form. Our Sixth Form team would like to invite all of our Year 11 students and their families to join us for the Sixth Form Open Evening on **Thursday 14th November 2024.**

Even if your child is still considering their options for post 16 study, we would warmly welcome all students to attend the event to meet the staff, learn more about the subjects and qualifications offered and have the opportunity to ask any questions! We also welcome external applications and details of how to apply can be found on our website. To attend the Open Evening, you do not need to pre-register and parking is available onsite.

Reminder for Reporting Student Absence

Have a safe Diwali


