## PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

As a part of your child's education at Cox Green School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, strategies and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. All PSHE teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.

Year 7 have been learning about the importance of building relationships as part of their relationships and sex education (RSE) curriculum. This has included learning about the features of healthy relationships, recognising and challenging media stereotypes and the importance of consent.

Year 8 have been learning about why discrimination is wrong and the importance of challenging discrimination in all its forms. This has included learning about key values and recognising different forms of discrimination.

Year 9 have been learning about intimate relationships and respectful relationships. This has included learning about readiness for sexual activity, facts and misconceptions relating to consent and safer sex.

Year 10 have been learning about community cohesion and challenging extremism. This has included learning about valuing diversity, preventing extremism and safely challenging discrimination.
