Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 7 Home Learning

It has been a pleasure seeing how Year 7 have grown emotionally and, in some cases, physically over the past several weeks. They have made a seamless transition to secondary school, and I would like to thank you for your significant contribution to their success.

As I mentioned during the Year 7 Welcome Afternoon a couple of weeks ago, I wanted to follow up on some of the queries we have received regarding the school's home learning process for those parents and carers who were unable to attend, but also as a reminder for those who were able to attend.

For every student each piece of home learning is set on the Microsoft Teams platform and should last between 20 and 40 minutes. Students can access their home learning tasks at home using their Microsoft 365 login, which is their school login details. The entry on Microsoft Teams will either detail what the home learning task is, with any appropriate resources attached, or if the home learning task is on another web-based learning platform, which platform the task is on.

Every entry on Microsoft Teams feeds directly into the Homework area of Edulink One, so students, parents and carers can see what has been set and when the home learning is due. Once a piece of home learning has been completed it should be marked as submitted by the student, so their teacher knows that it has been completed.

Several subjects utilise online learning platforms to set home learning tasks on. I have listed the platforms that are used in Year 7 below and how your child can log on to each of them; however, if you would like greater clarity around the logging on process for each, please click on this link [Remote Learning Portal](#) which will take you to the area of the school website where written instructions detailing how to login successfully are located.

- **Microsoft Teams:** students login using their school login details.
- **Edulink One:** students log into their school Microsoft account.
- **Pearson Active Hub** (used by Maths): students login using their school login details.
- **Sparx Science** (used by Science): students log into their school Microsoft account.
- **Memrise** (used by MFL): students login using their school login details.
- **Seneca** (used by multiple subjects): students log into their school Microsoft account.
