### **Year 10 GCSE Compulsory Geography Field Trip to Bournemouth – Friday 4 July 2023**

As part of the GCSE Geography course, students are to complete one day of compulsory fieldwork in order to experience 'practical geography', and have hands on experience of collecting and processing data, in order to come to a substantiated conclusion to answer an enquiry question.

It has become a tradition for our Geography students to visit Bournemouth for their field trip, as this provides an ideal location to study coastal processes as well as human impacts in the town. Students will be divided into groups to complete data collection at three sites, with each group led by a Geography teacher.

The cost of this trip is £15.70 and to book your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your sQuid account. This will be open from today (closing: 10pm on Sunday 4 June 2023).

We will leave school at 8.30am and travel to Bournemouth by coach, returning for 3.00pm. Students should wear appropriate clothing and footwear suitable for the coast and weather conditions on the day (including being on the beach). Students should bring with them a full pencil case, including pencils as they will be drawing, along with a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day. Students may wish to bring some money as there **may** be an opportunity to have some free time after lunch, before returning. Please note, eating and drinking on the coach is not allowed.

If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
